	<p> May drive and need not notify the DVLA. There must be no other disqualifying condition.</p>	<p> May drive but must notify the DVLA. Driving may be relicensed only if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li> there is no symptomatic myocardial ischemia, and</li><li> the exercise or other functional test requirements can be met (see Appendix C, page 111).</li></ul>
